



## **Parent Financial Commitment Form**

**I / we understand and agree to the following commitments:**

### **A. FINANCIAL COMMITMENT**

1. We agree to pay the tuition, late pick up charges, library fees, and any other school related fees on the 1<sup>st</sup> business day of each month. Our tuition payment preference is  Please checkmark one of the following:
  - "1 Pay" Tuition due by July 31 (\$100 off each tuition if paid by July 31)
  - OR**
  - "10 Pay" Tuition installment payments are due on the 1<sup>st</sup> business day of each month August through May.
2. Due on the 1<sup>st</sup> business day of the month are all late pick up fees, other fees and tuition.
3. **There is a \$25 late charge on all fees and charges not paid by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month.**
4. In the event the accounting office has not received payment within 40 days after the due date, your student(s) will be suspended from attending Golden Hills Christian School and all extracurricular activities until the account is paid in full to date.
5. In the event that your account should remain delinquent after 40 days and upon the discretion of Golden Hills Christian School, your account may be turned over to a professional agency for collection.
6. There will be a \$20 charge for any check returned to the school by the bank for any reason.
7. Re-enrollment, report cards and other school privileges will be withheld if your family account is not paid in full.
8. Delinquent tuition and fees must be paid in full before June 30 in order to continue at Golden Hills Christian School the following year.

These financial policies and parent commitment are understood to be legally binding; the parent is expected to have read and thereby agrees to comply with the above policy and commitment.

### **B. WITHDRAWAL POLICY**

1. GHCS does not enroll a student on a month-to-month or semester basis. It is understood that once enrolled, each child will attend for the entire school year. A two week written notification is required to withdraw a student. Families who withdraw during the school year will be assessed a charge of \$50.

### **C. GENERAL COMMITMENTS**

1. To support wholeheartedly a God-centered view of truth and man as presented in the Bible. Seeking to grow in our relationship with Jesus Christ, we will regularly attend a biblically based church as a family, will comply with God's standards for marriage and family living and will encourage our children to be involved in church youth activities.

2. To show honor and respect to the Holy Trinity and to the Bible, as God's Word. Further, we agree that our children will be respectful of adult authority and will be obedient to the GHCS procedures, rules and policies and uphold biblical standards of discipline at home.
3. To accept that Golden Hills Christian School is a ministry that is governed by Golden Hills Community Church.
4. To accept all rules and regulations of the school, GHCS Parent Handbook, and to accept and support the decisions and authority of the school's teachers, Principal, Administration and Golden Hills Community Church.
5. To authorize the school to administer such disciplinary measures as may be deemed necessary and proper by the Administration/Principal.
6. To uphold the Golden Hills Christian School's standards of excellence spiritually, academically, socially and physically. We will work closely with the teachers in these areas by providing a place of study at home, by supervising homework, encouraging timely completion of all assignments and taking an active role in our child(ren)'s education.
7. To provide at the time of admission any information that will assist faculty and staff in assessing and effectively meeting the educational needs of our child(ren), such as reporting any prescribed program of medication, reporting results of educational testing or tutoring and reporting any past problems.
8. To be financially responsible for any injury to any person, or damage to the property of others caused by our child(ren).
9. To support Golden Hills Christian School with our time, talents and resources through involvement in the school activities, and whenever possible, attending school-sponsored activities.
10. It is a privilege to attend the Golden Hills Christian School and therefore we will uphold the school through our prayers and positive attitude, and follow the Matthew 18 principle with regard to concerns.

#### **D. COMPLIANCE**

1. Inability or unwillingness to comply with the terms of this Parent Commitment Form may result in removal of your child(ren) from the school until compliance is achieved.
2. We understand that if any part of the application is found to be erroneous my child(ren) may be subject to immediate dismissal.
